July 5, 2021 - London East Central Catholic Family of Parishes St. Patrick, Our Lady of Czestochowa and St. Mary

For several years, we have seen a rapid decline in vocations to the priesthood not only in Canada but also around the world. To meet pastoral needs, the Diocese of London is reorganizing to ensure that all the faithful can enjoy the sacraments. This reorganization involves the creation of new Parish Families with several parishes. As of January this year our parish was incorporated into the new **parish family** along with **Our Lady of Czestochowa and St. Mary** and will start working together on July 5th. It is a specific Parish Family, because the faithful are of 3 nationalities: Polish, Italians, Hungarians. Responding to the needs of the diocese and at the request of Bishop Ronald Fabbro, Michaelite Fathers (Fr. Wes Chudy, Fr. Adam Gabriel and Fr. Peter Wojakiewicz) are taking responsibility of the pastoral duties in this Parish Family. The Name of our Parish Family was approved by Bishop Ronald Fabbro: "**London East Central Catholic Family of Parishes**". Our Family of Parishes includes not only churches, adjacent parish buildings, schools and nursing homes but due to the fact that Our Lady of Czestochowa Parish and part of Saint Mary Parish are also personal parishes, which take care of Poles and Italians living throughout the city of London and beyond. It should be noted that the new Parish Family will be served in the near future by only two priests, so we must all be prepared for various changes, especially the schedule of the Masses on Sundays and during the week. These changes will require us to reread the mission that the Church sets for us. This mission is, above all, to be open to others, to accept everyone we meet on our way and to help them to find a way to Christ. We must not shut ourselves up within the narrow walls of our sacred buildings, but must go out and proclaim the Good News to others. All of us together with our leaders. Therefore, let us ask for the gifts of the Holy Spirit, so that, like the Apostles on Pentecost were filled with power from on high, we may take up the new tasks assigned to us by Jesus with courage.

After the six months of hard work with our Parish Councils, the Transition Team and the Parish Staff we are very happy to announce to you that as of **July 5** we are starting a new chapter as **London East Central Catholic Family of Parishes**. Amen.
